26 April - 5 June	Formed at Southwick Park, Portsmouth, C-in-C's camp at Broomfield House; Tac embarked from there for France.
7 June - 23 June	Chateau at GREVILLY, Normandy.
23 June - 3 August	BLAY.
3 August - 14 August	Forest of GERISY.
14 August - 19 August	CAMPREUX near le BERTY BOGAGE.
19 August - 25 August	High ground northeast of CONDE sur NOIREAU.
25 August - 30 August	AVESNES-sous-MONS west of GAGE.
30 August - 1 Sept.	High ground above FONTAINES sous JOUY (R. SURE).
1 Sept - 3 Sept	Chateau de DANGU.
3 Sept - 4 Sept	COMTY.
4 Sept - 6 Sept	Chateau de SAULTY near ARRAS.
6 Sept - 8 Sept	Chateau de HOUTAINO near ATH, Belgium.
8 Sept - 21 Sept	Chateau at EVERBERG east of BRUSSELS.
21 Sept - 27 Sept	BOURG LEOPOLD.
27 Sept - 22 Oct	BRINHOVEN (Holland).
22 Oct - 12 Nov	C-in-C in BRUSSELS at Main Hq 21 Army Group. (C-in-C in England 6 - 10 Nov).
12 Nov 44 - 7 Feb 45	ZONHOVEN for the winter (C-in-C in England 25 Jan - 3 Feb).

7 Feb - 11 March	CELDRUP near BRINHOVEN (Holland).
11 March - 17 March	Woods west of VENLO.
17 March - 29 March	Hiding School south of STRALEN (Germany).
29 March - 31 March	Woods west of BORNHARDT.
31 March - 3 April	Woods north of BRUNEN (Over the Rhine).
3 April - 6 April	quarry north of HOTTULN.
6 April - 10 April	GAF Barracks, RHEINE.
10 April - 14 April	OSTENWALDE Chateau.
14 April - 21 April	Woods northwest of NIMBURG.
21 April - 1 May	SOLTAU.
1 May -	LUNEBURG HEATH near Wendisch Evern, where the Instrument of Unconditional Surrender was signed by the Germans at 1830 hours on 4 May, 1945.
