REGIMENTAL ACT OF REMEMBRANCE PARADE: SUNDAY 26 APRIL, 2020 COMMANDING OFFICER'S DIRECTION TO THE REGIMENT:



The Act of Remembrance Parade format
will be as follows:

- At the invitation of St Andrew's Presbyterian Church, the Regiment will arrive from MPA after the Church's regular Sunday morning service is concluded. The officers and soldiers will march into the church for the "Act of Remembrance" ceremony.
- The traditional Act of Remembrance will be conducted after, and outside of, the Church service, with the sequence of events is as follows:
 - The Colours are paraded into the church, and are placed on the Communion Table with Colour Officers retiring after the Colours are deposited;
 - The National Anthem is played;
 - The Regimental Padre or the Honorary Chaplain (the Senior Minister of the Church) will explain the reason for, and the historical context of, the Act of Remembrance (why we are here, why we remember, who we remember);
 - Act of Remembrance: Sgts advance and turn a page in the Book of Remembrance;

THE SECOND ANNUAL VIMY COMMEMORATION CEREMONY



All Highlanders and readers of **THE FALCON** who may be travelling to **France** and be in the **Vimy area on 9 April 2020** are cordially invited to attend the **second annual Vimy commemoration ceremony** at the **15th Battalion Vimy Cross Memorial in Ecurie**.

The ceremony will commence at **11:00hrs** followed by a post service reception in the town hall at 1200hrs.

- Playing of Last Post, Lament, Reveille;
- The Act of Remembrance Sgts retire;
- Colour Officers advance to reclaim Colours;
- The Royal Anthem is played;
- Colours retire and exit the church;
- The Regiment departs out of the church; and
- The Regiment forms up outside, marches past the HCol and parades back to MPA along the traditional route.

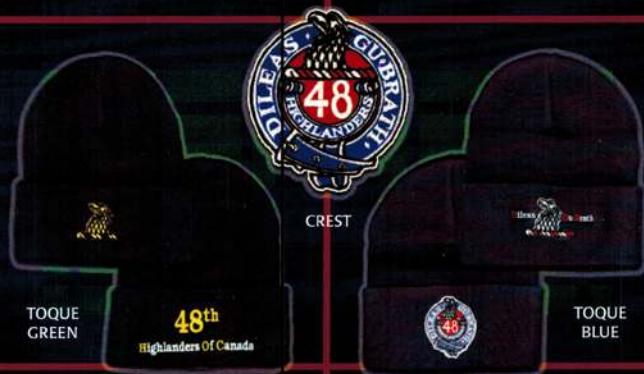
