ASCRPTION OF PRAISE

LAYING UP OF THE COLOURS

Immediately after the Ascription the Clergy will proceed to the North Door. The Adjutant knocks three times on the door with his sword hilt.

The Minister and Chaplain open the doors. The Adjutant then says, "Sir, I have been commanded by Lieut.-Colonel Corbett, commanding the 48th Highlanders of Canada to inform the authorities of this Church, that he has repaired here today with the Old Colours of the Regiment, and desires admission to proffer a request that they may be deposited herein."

The Minister shall answer: "Sir, inform Lieut.-Colonel Corbett that every facility will be given him in executing his most laudable purpose."

Upon this being communicated to the Commanding Officer a Procession will be formed and advance to the Chancel Steps the Congregation standing. On the arrival of the Procession at the Chancel Steps the Congregation will be seated.
