312147	1 Feb 44		<p>Coys spent the day tidying their areas and preparing for Lt-col I. S. JOHNSTON, DSO inspection 2nd and 3rd of Feb 44. In the morning Lt-col I. S. JOHNSTON, DSO, went out with Capt J. S. MACPARLANE, O.C. "B" coy, Lt J. R. FRARSON, signal officer, CSM Gunn to receive a Bn HQ position within the Bde reserve area. Lt-col I. S. JOHNSTON, DSO, returned to Main HQ for lunch and after lunch visited the Brigadier. At 1530 hrs he brought news back that Main HQ would move from its present location to Bde reserve area. The II &amp; IER to occupy our former position and thus make the change over complete. Major I. S. WALLACE, O.C. "B" coy, made plans to move his coy also. Arrangements were made for approx 15 of our personnel to attend a moving picture in ORTONA each day. Capt D. S. BEAL on leave. No shelling in Bn areas this night. Weather - clear and sunny.</p>	<i>WAM</i>
	2 Feb 44		<p>The Bn moved its Main HQ to new area and by noon all sub-units were in position. Bn HQ at 312147, "B" coy 320137. In the morning "B" coy was inspected and given a talk by Lt-col I. S. JOHNSTON, DSO, after which "C" coy given their inspection. The Adjutant, Capt Blair S. BRY, MC, and the Paymaster Capt L. J. PATTERSON, accompanied Lt-col I. S. JOHNSTON, DSO, so that each coy had its men paid, Commanding Officer's Orders and general inspection. During the morning and afternoon the I.C., Lt R. W. MESHURICH was active getting our areas clear of Italian civilians. 3-ton trucks were laid on by tpt to carry civilians and the personal effects to ABBOT at ORTONA. There was no H.S. in our areas this night. 17 OR reinforcements arrived to-day. Weather - clear and sunny.</p>	<i>WAM</i>

	5 Feb 44		<p>Last night still no H.S. in any of our areas. One contact patrol to H &amp; PER 2300 hrs. During the morning "D" coy was inspected. Lt-col I.S. JONESTON, DSO, learned from Major J.R.G. COUNSELL that from certain positions in his area he was under direct observation. It was decided to make certain alterations for defence of the area to tie in with left flank of 2 Cdn Inf Bde. The Brigadier called in at A Mess and spent some time with Major D.A. MacKENNIE. In the afternoon "A" coy had their inspection, etc. "B" coy announced their intention to fire PIAT at a derelict tank in "B" coy area. Bde gave permission to carry out this firing. Capt G.S. BEAL reported back from 48 hrs leave and proceeded to "A" coy as 2nd in command. During the night at approx 0330 hrs the enemy put some 2 dozen shells quite close to our Bn HQ area, it sounded like an 88mm or some high velocity weapon. Some rounds also fell in the "A" coy positions. No casualties. Weather - still clear and warm.</p>	<i>WJW</i>
	4 Feb 44		<p>At 1000 hrs Gp coy were given their inspection. Major I.S. WALLACE supplied a pipe for the occasion. During the morning the BASK LI Officer called in at A Mess to explain location of his Bn HQ. Also an L.O. from Bde gave warning of a move for us to positions in rear. A bn comms conference was called for 1400 hrs at Bde. We gained the following information: 3 Cdn Inf Bde to relieve 1 Cdn Inf Bde. 48th to be relieved by R 22 R on the 8 Feb 44. On or about 17 Feb 44 1 Cdn Inf Bde to relieve 2 Cdn Inf Bde. 2 Cdn Inf Bde may then relieve 1 Cdn Inf Bde or 3 Cdn Inf Bde as conditions decide. Lt-col I.S. JONESTON, DSO, back at Main HQ 1600 hrs called coy comms conference for 1000 hrs 3 Feb 44. Contact patrol from 4 pl to H &amp; PER 2300 hrs, NTR. No H.S. during night in our areas, some rain fell. 18 CR reinforcements ton. Weather - cloudy and cool.</p>	<i>WJW</i>

Probably 2 or 4 days delay. GSO 1 at Div, Lt-col Melis BARDING paid us a visit to see positions. Quiet day with Bn HQ personnel off to see a movie in the PM. 	8 Feb 44		Nothing happened all day. Troops doing best to keep dry and warm. Capt J. S. MACPARKIN sees to 1 Cdn Inf Bde. Weather - rainy and cold.	KAM

McKENNETH who reported it was punk, hard to get at and full of Italian civilians, however, as it rained and snowed all day he was probably prejudiced. Anything looks bad in this weather. 	10 Feb 44		<p>Snowed during night and everything in sight is flooded, as the sun soon thawed the snow. Plans for move were as follows:- A, F and B echelons to move from BUNDEE crossroads at 1400 hrs. Marching troops to embark at same place at 1700 hrs. Original plan called for a stage overnight at POMBACEDIA but Lt-col I.S. JOHNSON, BDE, decided it would be better to have troops march direct to new area from KOGGA and have everyone under cover the same night. This was undoubtedly a sound idea, the only flaw being that all the Bn H. and H. coy vehicles were fast in the mud. With the combined aid of two scammells they were eventually pried loose by 1700 hrs too late for the 1400 hr convoy but in time to join the Rifle Coy convoy. When the troops debussed and marched to their area Capt Blair S. REY, MC, was left in charge of Bn H. and H. coy vehicles and to bring them in, in the AM. This because the road from KOGGA was in too bad shape to try in the dark. A night in the open was quite a shock to Bn H. personnel but they came through with flying colours. Lt S.H. 

	29 Feb 44		<p>The Brigadier and Bde. I.C. arrived at 1000 hrs at Tac H.Q. Lt-col. Johnston and the S i/c, Major MacKensie, remained at H.Q. during the morning. Seven day leave personnel were sent out from "C" Coy at 1130 hrs. During the afternoon the Arty fired a deception shoot from 1600 hrs to 1630 hrs, no retaliation of any extent was made. Lt-col. Johnston visited the R.C.A. positions during the afternoon. At 1830 hrs a Coy Comdrs. conference was held at Tac H.Q. The following information was given: (1) Bns. of 1 C.I.B. to occupy positions for five day 'stands'. 3. RESTRICTIONS ON PURCHASES BY THE ALLIED ARMY IN ITALY

1. The orders restricting the purchase of foodstuffs by the Allied Forces in ITALY have been issued by Adv AFHQ after most careful consideration for the following reasons:

- There is a serious shortage of foodstuffs available in occupied ITALY for the civil population.
- It is essential in our common interests to reduce to the minimum possible the shipping tonnage required for imports into ITALY on purely civil accounts. Tonnage saved by husbanding local resources permits the import of an equivalent tonnage of war materials for our forces.

Documents, secret and otherwise, and maps have been left in evacuated buildings that have served as H's and had these fallen into the hands of the enemy they would have provided him with excellent material with which to supplement his intelligence.

5. HAIRCUTS

The hair of the head will be cut short (IR 1272). It will not be permitted to wear sideburns.

6. WALKING OUT DRESS

Walking out dress will be - waist belt, puttees, balmoral or slungarry.

7. OWN SOLDIERS WIVES IN UK

1. Certain rumours have been circulated both within and without 1 Cdn Corps to the effect that English wives of Cdn soldiers are being compulsorily returned to Canada on the basis that their husbands are out of the UK.

2. There is NO truth in this rumour.

3. A circular has been sent with dependents allowance cheques, at the end of February, informing all UK wives of the provision of Overseas RO 3322, paras 1 - 8. These paras, in brief, state that free transportation to Canada will be provided for all dependents of soldiers, but only in exceptional circumstances will a dependent be eligible for free transportation until the soldier is returning to Canada for discharge or some other permanent purpose. Wives have also been informed of the address of the Cdn Immigration Department in LONDON and have been advised to retain this information for further use.

8. BLANKET WASTAGE

1. Blanket wastage has become a serious operational item.

2. Unauthorized use of BLANKETS and GREYCOATS for modifying jenkins leather and manufacture into jackets and berets will cease forthwith.

3. This order also applies to the practice of having service protectors cut off short.

4. Disciplinary action will be taken against anyone found disobeying this order.

9. COMMUNIQUE - GREEN ENVELOPES

The Chief Base Censor reports that Gns frequently fail to realize that enclosed letters must bear the recipient's address, and be sealed.

The following points are emphasized:-

(a) Up to three letters may be enclosed in one Green Envelope.

(b) When only one letter is enclosed the Green Envelope will be addressed to the recipient in the normal way.

recipient and will be sealed.

- (d) In all cases, the certificate on the front of the envelope will be signed by the writer.

Failure to comply with the above regulations will cause considerable delay to letters which must be returned to the writer.

10. REFUEL CANISTER USE

All ranks must be warned that there is a shortage of jerrycans and all empties must be returned to salvage. Care must be taken that caps are firmly replaced so that dirt and water will not get into the can and thereby contaminate the petrol when the can is refilled.

11. WEARING OF PUTTEES

All ranks are again reminded that when puttees are worn they will be put on with the point on the outside facing the rear. Officers will check their men in this regard.
