KINGSWOOD

- 1 Companies carried on with training in accordance with syllabus (App 1), route march in the afternoon. App. 1
- 2 Companies carried on with training syllabus, all ranks including cooks and drivers given a brushing up in S.A.T.
- 3 Companies carried on with training during the morning. In the afternoon there were organized sports, but day was dull and raining.
4. Training in accordance with syllabus. A and D coys went to Ash No.1 Range for rifle practices while B and C coy attended M.O. parade for Anti-tetanus inoculations. In the afternoon B and C coys rested and then went for short march.
5. Kit and line inspection in the morning, sports in the afternoon while a percentage were allowed out to nearby towns, returning for roll call at 1700 hrs.
6. Divine service held in company lines where not practical for companies to go to church.
7. Training as usual in accordance with Syllabus. Unit signal section put through phone connections with T.O. and Q.M. as G.P.O. not satisfactory.
8. Muster parade in morning, marching to and from parachute areas during the afternoon, getting familiar with ground.
9. Company Commanders parade in the morning. Sports in the afternoon, which included boxing and tug of war team work. Plenty of aerial activity high up, but no results below.
10. Balance of unit given Anti-tetanus inoculation in the morning and then allowed to rest as unit was supplying T.C.F. personnel for Divisional move.
11. Companies carried on with training in small arms, with a route march in the afternoon.
12. Billets and kit were inspected in the morning, with squad drill and marching later on. In the afternoon organized sports were taken part in by the companies.
13. The companies paraded to church service separately. REIGATE road closed due to a delayed action bomb near Reigate hill.
14. Pay day for the companies. Companies paid in rotation and in the meantime carrying on with training.
15. Carried on with company training in accordance with syllabus with short route march in the afternoon.
16. Training carried on in company areas in Field Craft.
17. Very long route march all day with rations delivered to a pre-arranged R.V. One of the longest marches this unit has done in ENGLAND.

- 18 Training as usual in small arms and anti-gas precautions. Signal Section laid cable to "A" Coy as communication arrangements via G.P.O. were unsatisfactory.
- 19 Brigade move of transport, with all available personnel. Kit and line inspection in the late morning.
- 20 Battalion paraded to Divine Service under company arrangements. Padre conducted as many of company services as possible.
- 21 Training by companies in accordance with syllabus. Field Craft training in afternoon in company arrangements. B.H.C. sent a party to help clean up debris of Col. Stowells' house which had been bombed.
- 22 Brigade collective exercise. Went very smoothly, except for the weather which was dull and rainy. Left Company lines at 0400 hrs travelled 50 miles and put on infantry cum tank scheme. Arrived back in company lines at 1930 hrs.
- 23 Small arm training in the morning. In the afternoon organized sports. Sports were competitive with platoon against platoon and in the case of baseball company versus company.
- 24 Weather very dull with rain, so training confined to indoors on lectures etc.
- 25 Battalion route march of 21 miles distance. Commenced at 0800 hrs and returned at 1600 hrs to company lines. Much aerial activity, but nothing landed.
- 26 Kit and billet inspection in the morning with platoon drill later. In the afternoon sports.
- 27 Divine Service at St. Andrew's Church.
- 28 Training in T.O.E.F.'s progressing favorably. In the afternoon did some work on sand tables outside as the sun was shining.
- 29 Part of Bn went to No. 1 Ash Ranges for Rifle and Bren Gun practices. Men transported by unit transport, but had to walk about 10 miles on way back as a route march.
- 30 Lectures in the morning on respirator, its construction and care. In the afternoon sports with company tug of war teams competing.
- 31 Tank hunting training in company lines. Stetcher Bearers taking a refresher course with M.O.
